1st Belper Scouts Code of Conduct

1. Arrive on time, in uniform, and wear it smartly with pride.
2. Mobiles should be switched off or to silent during meetings and left in pockets.
3. Listen to Leaders and PL's and follow their instructions ; Don't interrupt or mess about when they are talking, be alert.
4. Have respect for: others, their belongings, the hut and the flag.
5. No bullying of any kind, no violence and no acting silly.
6. No inappropriate language or swearing, be polite.
7. Everyone's here to enjoy themselves and have fun.

1st Belper Scout Group Behaviour Policy

- Both parents/guardians/carers and children will sign and return the Code of Conduct for their Section before they can attend meetings
- Firstly, a verbal request will be made by leaders/helpers to the child to stop their inappropriate actions or behaviour.
- If the poor behaviour/actions continue, the leader will issue a "Yellow Card".
- On the third occasion, a second "Yellow Card", with consequence e.g. 5 minutes sin bin, will be issued and the parents will be told on collection about the poor behaviour.
- Should this happen for a fourth time in one night, this will be classified "Red" and the parent/carer/guardian will be asked to collect their child immediately. The child will also automatically forfeit the following week's attendance, or weekend, no matter what is planned. (any monies paid will not be refundable).
- Upon return, if at any time another red card has to be issued, the child will be asked to leave 1st Belper Scout Group permanently.
- All acts of vandalism and violence are an automatic red card and in extreme cases will mean instant dismissal. This is not to be tolerated

As well as this, we have a type of reward system. Both the Beavers and Cubs have a mascot for child of the week, which they are able to take home and look after for the following week. There can also be stickers and certificates too. We want to be careful that we do not become 'like schools' but both the committee and section leaders feel that we should recognise the good behaviour that most of our members display.
